History of UMT

- Higher Medical Institute since 1952.
- On 1957 was joint to University of Tirana as Faculty of Medicine.
- University of Medicine, Tirana (UMT) was created in 2013, as a continuity of Faculty of Medicine, separating from University of Tirana.
- The UMT has three faculties:
 - Faculty of Medicine
 - Faculty of Dental Medicine
 - Faculty of Technical Medical Sciences




